WINES coming out of the Riverina district have been pecking away at acceptance and distribution to the point that discerning wine buffs are reaching out to try the latest vintages.

This is happening not just in Australia but also overseas, with Beelgara Fine Wines moving into the top sellers.

Their 2007 Beelgara Rascals Prayer Sauvignon Blanc is best described as being a little cheeky, fresh and with quite definite flavours.

Pickers are out in the vineyard selecting fruit for this wine late at night, so the TLC is there right from the first signs of fruiting.

Well priced at about \$14, there is no doubting in my mind that it will take the summer months by storm - it's a perfect summer drink. For a food match I'd suggest seafood or poultry.
